

# General measures to minimize exposure to Equine Herpesvirus-1 (Rhinopneumonitis) during the event Pompadour Complet from 12th April to 14nd April 2021

***This event is organized by the “Société de Concours Hippiques de Pompadour” International event - 4\*-S***

***Veterinary protocol for Equine Herpesvirus-1 (Rhinopneumonitis) - on April 2nd, 2021***

**The site is only accessible to the horses who participate at the event.**

*Arrival of horses :*

**All the horses must stay in the Haras, none of them is allowed to stay in another stable.**

**To enter the site, you must present :**

**1/ a certificate of good health made by a veterinarian (attached document)**

**2/ a valid vaccination certificate**

**3/ all horses must have their temperature checked immediately on arrival and before entering the closed stable. The temperature must be checked twice a day (morning and evening) . Please bring your own thermometer and pen.**

The arrival will be in Thalian, **between 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm on April, 11th.**

- The certificate of good health (one certificate by truck/stable of departure with the full name of each horse) dated not earlier than April 9th + the documents justifying the professional status of the riders) No horse unmentioned on the veterinarian certificate will be admitted on the site of competition. The veterinarian certificate must attest the good health of all the horses, and the fact that the stable of departure is healthy too.
- The FEI horses will all stay in the Puy Marmont site, in a closed stable. A night guard/watchman will assure the guarding of the stable and will have all the recommendations from the officials of the competition, as well as the emergency contacts.
- The declaration of starters will be done **over the phone before 5:00 pm on April, 11th.**
- Dr Heng will verify the identity and health of the horses from 7:00 pm in the stable. Thank you for being in the stable at this moment.
- **all horses must have their temperature checked immediately on arrival and before entering the closed stable. The temperature must be checked twice a day (morning and evening) . Please, leave the temperature record sheet on the stall door as the organization has to collect all of them at the issue of the competition. Thanks.**

*Stables*

- The Stable Manager and his assistants will be on site from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm
- Night guard at night (details above)
- Opening hours of the stables : from 6:00 am (or 2 hours before the competition starts) to 10:00 pm  
In case of emergency outside the opening hours, please contact the night guard : [#phone number to come]

*Veterinary stables :*

- 5 stables are reserved at the end of a stable (isolated and closed stables, near an independant access of the Haras) → Périgueux platform (Choisel) → in case of the need to isolate a horse
- 2 stables are reserved on the Périgueux platform for doping controls
